

General Privacy Statement

Any personal information which you volunteer to Lynch Fashions will be treated with the highest standards of security and confidentiality, in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1988, the Data Protection (Amendment) Act, 2003 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This statement is not deemed to be a contractual undertaking.

Website Privacy

This Privacy Statement explains the privacy guidelines that Lynch Fashions has adopted for its website. This policy relates to website/pages hosted under the <http://lynchfashions.com/> domain only. Lynch Fashions is not responsible for the content or privacy practices of external websites.

Collection and use of your personal information

Lynch Fashions does not collect any personal data about you on this website, apart from information which you volunteer (for example by emailing us or by using our online application services). Any information, which you provide in this way, is used only in line with the purpose for which you provided it, and is not made available to any other third parties.

Lynch Fashions does not retain any personal information about web visitors on this website without permission, save in cases where the College is required by law to do so, such as the investigation of a criminal offence by the Gardaí, or a breach of Lynch Fashions's web-related policies, procedures or guidelines.

Technical details in connection with visits to this website may be logged on Lynch Fashions's server for accounting and auditing purposes (e.g. computer IP number). It is the policy of Lynch Fashions not to disclose such technical information in respect of individual website visitors to any third-party unless obliged to disclose such information by a rule of law. The technical information will be used only for statistical and other administrative purposes. You should note that technical details, which Lynch Fashions cannot associate with any identifiable individual, do not constitute "personal data" for the purposes of the Data Protection Acts 1988 and 2003 and/or GDPR.

Cookies

Cookies may be used by this website to collect non-personal information about how visitors use our website. Cookies may also be used to remember your display preferences (e.g. preferred text size) the next time you visit. We may use cookies as part of Google Analytics, and other web analytics services that enables us to track how visitors use our website. Google Analytics, uses first party cookies. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser.

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of <http://lynchfashions.com/>.

Temporary session cookies may also be used in some areas to enable specific functionality. Session cookies are deleted once you leave the website. Non-session cookies exist on your computer for 30 days after you have visited but they contain no private or sensitive data (e.g. the cookie that preserves your text magnification is called “fontsize” and only contains the number 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 depending on the magnification you last selected). Lynch Fashions does not use malware, spyware or adware in any form or fashion. Lynch Fashions does not gather any personal information without your express permission.

Lynch Fashions uses every appropriate physical and technical organisational security measures to prevent unauthorised access, alteration or destruction of your personal information. These measures are reviewed regularly. Data transmission over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.
